Charlotte Gem Preservation Awards Event Information:

- 1. Estimated 500 people total
- 2. Indoor event can fit 15 tables of 10 in the Great Hall
 - a. Table seating tickets 150 people plated meals
 - b. Standing room ticket 300+ people standing food (i.e. finger food)
- 3. Budget: \$30,000 including tax and fees (minimum spend would be \$25,000 including tax and fees)
- 4. Event theme Jewels & Gems of History & Preservation
 - a. Gemstone (Sapphire, Emerald, and Diamond) to play off the 'gem' word; at a minimum this can inform the linen colors
 - b. The award winners are the "Gems of Preservation."
 - c. Key Exhibits on Display: "Charlotte: Signs of Home," "Siloam School," "Path of Portraits," and "Captured in Cartoons" as well as the 1774 Alexander Rock House and grounds which will be accessible during the event.
- 5. Caterer to Provide:
 - a. Food staff for four food stations located in a single gallery
 - b. Bartender staff for 2 fixed bars Beer, Wine, and single cocktail (mule shine)
 - c. Bartender staff for moonshine tasting station.
 - d. We will be having one signature cocktail called a mule shine.
 - e. Set up, clean up and all needs for food display.
 - f. All utensils and small wares.
