Mad About Modern home tour announces new cocktail experience, free modernism lecture and midmod raffle

The Charlotte Museum of History presents the annual home tour to create appreciation for the Queen City's midcentury modern architecture and to encourage its preservation.

The museum will offer a free online talk with Susan Mayer of SVM Historical Consulting on Thursday, Sept, 10, from noon-12:45 p.m. Mayer will discuss midcentury modern architecture and why it continues to inspire well into the 21st century. "Cocktail minute" with Dot Dot Dot on Sept. 26

The museum has partnered with cocktail lounge Dot Dot Dot to offer an at-home cocktail experience on Saturday, Sept. 26, at 6 p.m. during its live-streamed, one-night-only event with Mr. Modernist, George Smart. Mixologist Brittany Clark will kick off the event by showing attendees how to mix two classic 1950s cocktails with a twist – the *Mad About Modern* Mule and the *Mad About Modern* Manhattan. Ticket holders can participate in two ways – follow Dot Dot Dot's recipe card or purchase a Cocktail Kit from Dot Dot Dot's website. Cocktail kits are \$16 each and make four cocktails. 2020 *Mad About Modern* home tour

The 2020 tour will feature 360° virtual tours of three homes in Coventry Woods, Eastover and Grove Park. The homes were built from the 1950s to the 1970s, and they showcase key elements of midcentury modern design, including asymmetrical profiles, expansive windows, open floor plans and living areas that blur the line between indoor and outdoor.

2020 ticket holders will get exclusive access to 360° tours of the featured homes, along with a digital guidebook highlighting the significant modernist features of each home. More information about this year's tour homes is at madaboutmodern.com.

The tour is a major fundraiser for the museum, with all proceeds supporting its mission of saving and sharing Charlotte's history. The *Mad About Modern* home tour received Charlotte Magazine's "Best of the Best" award for Best Home Tour in 2019.

"Charlotte Modernism" with the Lorax of Modernist Houses

The tour will feature a live, one-night-only lecture with modernism expert George Smart on Saturday, Sept. 26. Smart will share examples of the best midcentury modern design in Charlotte and explain how it relates to the global modernist movement. Smart is founder and executive director of NCModernist, a nonprofit organization that documents, preserves and promotes modernist design. Since 2007, Smart and his nonprofit staff and volunteers have built the largest open digital archives for residential midcentury modernist design in the world. Dwell magazine has called Smart the Lorax of Modernist houses.
